BIG BLUE KITTEN away without apparent mishap, was sent over to the rail during the long straight run leading up to the first turn, sat reseved there as his stablemate threw down lively fraction after lively fraction, was asked to pick up the pace proceeding to get taken outward nearintg the three-eighths pole, made into the four path a sixteenth down the lead, was set down challenging in earnest entering the stretch, scampered away to its biggest advantage during the ensuing furlong, drifited out in the late stages but had enough left to preserve the decision and establish a course record. SLUMBER (GB) was down along the rail like most of the others during the initial stages, was taken outward leaving the backstretch until in the three path by the midway point on the far turn, took the same path for entrance into the stretch, closed in well belatedly on the winner, reaching the wire in time himself to come out on top in the place photo. TWILIGHT ECLIPSE took the inside route, was forced to remain on hold, stuck behind the weakening SHINING COPPER starting from past the five-sixteenths pole until midlane, managed to angle into three path and into clearance, came home with good, but belated energy. RED RIFLE swung two wide into the backstretch, closed the gap on the pacesetter travelling on the far turn, was one of several bidding for command at the quarter pole, had the rider lose the whip with approximately a furlong remaining then tired. SHINING COPPER sprinted off and tucked along the inside, bounded along on an open lead, had the field close in rapidly starting from the three-eighths pole, gave in approaching the top of the lane and backed away. PERFECT TITLE saved ground to the quarter pole, was put four wide at the head of the stretch, had no offering. QUIET FORCE in the two path to the end of the backstretch, rode the rail on the turn two, failed to make any impact.
