**Footnotes**

SWEETEST SONG stalked the pace, rallied to catch BLUSHING DIXIE in early stretch, then edged away. EDEN'S STORM well placed racing along the rail, eased out in the stretch and finished willingly for the place. BLUSHING DIXIE moved through along the inside to gain the lead racing into the first turn, set the pace along the rail into the stretch and faltered. LOXY LADY outrun early, raced five wide around the far turn and closed with a mild rally. GRAN APPEAL raced in contention into the stretch and lacked a late response. JUST LIVIN A DREAM raced four wide and failed to menace. CRUISIN'NTHEBRIDLE saved ground to no avail. FLAMING ROSE was not a factor. AVERYMERRYMOMENT tracked the pace four wide into the stretch and tired. MINER'S TUNE showed brief speed, eased back to chase the pace from the outside into the far turn, then faltered in the drive. SCHLOSSGARTEN PARK was outrun. TRIPLE TAX EXEMPT chased the pace three wide into the far turn, then faded.
