BREAKING PROMISES opened clear to dictate terms, dug in to meet a series of challenges and gamely led throughout. NETWORKING settled in hand, was shuffled back between horses on the first turn, leveled into stride three wide, ranged into striking distance on the second turn, swung six wide entering the stretch, kept on well but was unable to reach the winner. MS ANNA DESTINY broke slow, moved up four wide to attend the pace, drew even nearing the quarter pole, but weakened during the drive and settled for the show. LIL MISS SMARTY K stalked the pace, came four wide to make a bold bid but failed to sustain the drive. REVELSTOKE fell far back six wide, tucked in a bit on the second turn, and finished with a belated gain four wide. SNOWSCAPE was hustled along six wide for six furlongs and faded. CHAMPAGNE JANE was never a factor. WINNERS GET EVEN showed little.
