BREAKING PROMISES vied for the lead two wide into the turn, dropped closer to the inside when dueling rival dropped out, was joined by another, repelled that challenger into the lane to gain a clear advantage then held on while under steady urging. NOTASSHARPASUTHINK settled off the pace while near the inside, bid into the lane to get nearest the winner then steadily gained on that one while second best. STAR PASSAGE was unhurried while off the inside, bid from the five path into the lane and moved up while not a threat. BIOGIO'S GIFT was in the two or three path through the turn and never was a serious threat. WINSOCKIE vied for the lead along the inside into the turn the faded. PERFECTLY CANDID was never a factor while saving ground. DIXIE JACKPOT vied for the lead while racing two or three wide into the lane and faded. BABES BRIDGE IT trailed throughout while coming widest into the lane.
