Footnotes

TOWNER contended along the inside, lost ground through the turn, waited in traffic entering the stretch, shifted out to find a seam, split rivals, finished with a surge and was up in the final stride. GRAND COULEE was forwardly placed between horses, angled in leaving the turn, was blocked entering the stretch, altered course out between horses inside the furlong marker, kicked on well but wasn't quite good enough. STARTER settled in hand three wide, tipped out further entering the stretch, quickened once clear and was gaining readily. PISGAH STATION hopped at the start, settled at the tail of the field under a snug hold, circled five wide to make a bold bid, opened clear a furlong out but weakened between horses and grudgingly gave in. GRAND IDOL tracked the pace three wide, but weakened between horses in the final furlong and faded. BULLDOG LEGEND was slow into stride, angled out to make a belated gain but failed to threaten. PRIMO set the pressured pace along the inside, contested the issue to the final furlong and faded. REVERE pulled to the fore three deep, lacked a response when called upon, came up empty in the final furlong and faded fast.
