CATHOLIC BOY given some mild encouragement after springing from the starting gate, established control, was rated along the inside, staked by the runner up in path two, saw ANALYZE IT latch on as three-quarters was being reached, was put a ride a sixteenth later, with the nemeis following suit by getting called upon himself two jumps later, inched its way onto the outer border of the inside route prior to turning into the lane, had the stretch drive commence with each equine leaning heavily on the other, as they would for the next sixteenth, lost a slight bit of ground after bumping with the second place finisher once into the furlong grounds, was forced to steady when intimidated/bothered in the vicinity of the furlong marker, took up the chase unasked for run until the sixteenth pole, shifted to be outside the runner up leaving that station, mustered up good courage to outkick ANAYZE IT in the final seventy yards to prove best. ANALYZE IT got set up in the two path after the break, picked up interest after departing the backstretch to draw up to the winner at the three-eighths pole, was abreast of that one when asked for more a short distance beyond the five-sixteenths pole, stepped into the lane on even terms with the winner and with each trying to out-muscle the other as they went at it shoulder to shoulder, grabbed away the advantage after solid contact was made in the general area of the three-sixteenths pole, began to shift toward the inside right afterwards, ultimately leading the top one to steady in tight and lose momentum in midlane, ventured onward with the advantage, felt the presence of CATHOLIC BOY yet again inside the sixteenth pole, fought with determination during their late stage duel but got reeled in. CHANNEL CAT saved ground on the opening bend, shifted into path two midpoint on the backstretch, was under a drive by the three-eighths pole, angled four to five wide into the lane and went on to secure the show. UNTAMED DOMAIN underwent a three wide journey, was put to a drive on the far turn, swung into the lane and was outfinished. IRISH TERRITORY (IRE) saved ground and faltered. Following a Stewards' Inquiry in addition to a claim of foul lodged by the rider of ANALYZE IT against the rider of CATHOLIC BOY alleging interference, the result was allowed to stand and the race was declared official.
