Footnotes

CLASS PRESIDENT went two to three wide on the first turn, was unhurried near the back of the field, dropped to the inside midway through the far turn, came out in upper stretch, rallied into the final furlong, closed strongly on the inside of the leaders and got up late. DREAMS CUT SHORT was reluctant to load, lingered well back in the field while off the inside, was roused on the far turn, came three wide into the stretch, moved further out once straightened for the drive, had the rider lose his whip while making a bid coming to the eighth-pole, battled gamely under strong hand urging in the final furlong and just missed in a three-way photo. AT THE PULPIT saved ground on the first turn, settled nicely off the pace, rallied two then three wide on the far turn, swept to the lead at the top of the stretch, dueled gamely in the final furlong and also just missed. UNREMITTING was a bit eager early, raced three wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, went four wide on the far turn, dropped to one off the rail near the five-sixteenths pole, was asked in upper stretch, angled out near the furlong marker and finished willingly. MYSTIC LEGEND went three wide on the first turn, was forwardly placed down the backstretch, chased four wide on the far turn, came five wide into the stretch, brushed with a rival shortly thereafter, bumped lightly with REASON TO BE PROUD near the furlong marker and weakened. REASON TO BE PROUD went five then four wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, was roused while three wide on the far turn, came four wide into the stretch, brushed with a rival shortly thereafter, bumped lightly with MYSTIC LEGEND near the furlong marker and also weakened. SING SONG CAT went three wide on the first turn, stalked the pace, made a bid near the five-sixteenths pole, vied into upper stretch then gave way. STREET FIGHT set the pace through moderate fractions, lost the lead at the top of the stretch and tired. MI LUNA GRANDE lagged at the rear of the field while saving ground, moved out in upper stretch, shifted further out in the vicinity of the eighth-pole and failed to threaten. ARCTIC HUNTER went four

wide on the first turn, raced up close on the outside, chased five wide on the far turn, came six wide into the stretch and capitulated. BAYOU VERMILION steadied off heels entering the first turn then bobbed and nearly unseated the rider, settled off the pace, raced inside on the far turn and came up empty. Following a stewards' inquiry into the stretch run, UNREMITTING was disqualified from fourth and placed sixth.
