DANCING SOLO outran GOOD MOTHER FRAN for the lead around the first turn, made the pace off the rail into the stretch, then drew off under while ridden out. SONG OF BERNADETTE rated off the pace after breaking awkwardly, raced four wide while moving up around the far turn, then drifted wide at the top of the stretch and closed to be up for the place while no match for the winner. BONJOUR BELLE allowed to settle after breaking slow and being steadied to avoid SONG OF BERNADETTE at the start, was fanned wide by that same rival at the top of the stretch and closed to be up for the show. TOPAZIO tracked the leaders three wide to midway of the far turn, then tired. CHANNEL LADY was not a factor. GOOD MOTHER FRAN pressed the early pace along the inside, chased the winner into the far turn, then faltered. SWAKOPMUND chased the pace into the stretch, then faded. ESS E CEE was through early.
