Footnotes

FONT was unhurried into stride, advanced between horses through the second turn, split rivals and angled out with a furlong to run, wore down the leader and was inching away. ALL FOR GEORGIA was forwardly along the inside, shifted out and drew even with five-sixteenths to run, shook clear entering the stretch but was unable to resist the winner. HEART UNION was unhurried early, tucked in to save ground, closed the gap between horses, got through toward the inside entering the stretch, swung to the outside for the final furlong and was making up ground. HAPPY CHOICE was allowed to settle, ranged into striking distance along the inside, bid between horses entering the stretch, was jostled between horses near the three-sixteenths pole, kept on well but wasn't quite good enough. AFFAIR DABBLER contended between horses, came three wide, veered in under right handed urging, bumped HAPPY CHOICE and flattened in the drive. LOHAN was allowed to settle, moved up between horses to make a mild bid but lacked the needed late response. FANCY POINT tracked the pace three wide, drew even after a half, but faltered on the second turn and faded. BREAKING PROMISES opened clear to set the pace, was collared after a half, weakened entering the stretch, was bumped hard and forced into the rail near the three-sixteenths pole, steadied and lost all chance. PURE VALUE was forwardly placed between horses, steadied from tight quarters midway through the second turn and retreated. GREY MIST failed to respond. HEY CARMEN was close up three wide for six furlongs and stopped. LETTER TO HENNY was through after a half. Following a Stewards inquiry into the stretch run, AFFAIR DABBLER was disqualified from fifth and placed eighth for veering in and bumping HAPPY CHOICE in the upper stretch.
