BREAKING PROMISES was allowed to settle, advanced between horses on the turn, wheeled out seven wide entering the stretch, finished full of run and edged clear late. ANEARLYBREEZE broke a step slow, rushed to the lead along the inside, fought on well through a long drive but was unable to resist winner. NOBILITY pressed the pace three deep, weakened slightly between horses but had enough left to hold the show. ARGUE attended the pace along the inside, got through entering the stretch to make a bold bid but failed to sustain the drive. SPANISH SILKS was forwardly placed three wide, was floated out a bit entering the stretch and lacked the needed late response. CHAPELLA stalked the pace, moved up five wide to make her bid but weakened. MS. TURDUCKEN raced wide throughout and was outrun. TRUE MARQUE was through early.
