Footnotes

GHOST IS CLEAR settled in hand, ranged into striking distance five wide through the turn, quickened inside the furlong marker and wore down PHILIPPE in the final yards. PHILIPPE stalked the pace three deep, launched a bold bid four wide, forged command with a furlong to run, continued on well but was unable to resist the winner. GETAWAY GUY set the pressured pace two wide, was headed a furlong out, weakened and settled for the minor award. BANJAMMER bobbled at the start, bumped MURJAN leaving the chute, settled toward the inside, angled out entering the stretch and improved position between rivals. DEVIL TRAIN attended the pace off of the inside, shifted out five wide leaving the turn, but lacked a response when called upon. GONNA TELL MAMA was hustled along on the inside, angled out three wide entering the lane to make a mild bid but failed to sustain the drive. CHASING MOONLIGHT failed to respond. BIG ALBERT contested the pace along the inside to the final furlong and faded. MURJAN broke a step slow, was bumped leaving the chute and slow into stride, and never recovered.
