## **Footnotes**

MISSION IMPAZIBLE was taken under a tight hold while showing early speed, contested the pace on the inside of BIRDRUN, picked up the tempo on the far turn, kicked clear when asked for more in upper stretch, was put to a right-handed whip near the furlong marker, switched to a left-handed whip outside the sixteenth-pole and held well under strong hand urging late. APART raced three wide on the first turn, tracked the leaders on the outside, went three wide on the far turn, was asked outside the five-sixteenths pole, chased under a left-handed whip in upper stretch, switched to a right-handed whip outside the furlong marker and determinedly earned the place. GIANT OAK raced three wide on the first turn, settled near the back of the field, was urged some while three wide on the far turn, shifted five wide over heels outside the quarter-pole, gained ground under the whip in upper stretch and finished willingly but just missed the place. FAST ALEX was reserved on the inside, inched a bit closer with a half-mile to run, was urged along while saving ground on the far turn, came under the whip in upper stretch and lacked the needed response. BIRDRUN was hustled from the start, raced three then two wide on the first turn, contested the pace on the outside, increased the tempo on the far turn, lost contact with the winner in upper stretch and weakened. EL CABALLO stumbled at the start, raced off the rail on the initial turn, settled in the middle of the field, was ridden along while off the rail on the far turn and failed to rally. DEMARCATION raced off the rail while between rivals on the first turn, was unhurried at the back, went two then three wide on the far turn, swung five wide at the top of the stretch and also failed to rally. COUNTRY FLAVOR broke a bit slow, raced four wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, chased four wide on the far turn, came under a left-handed whip in upper stretch and capitulated.
