ELUSIVE GRACE bumped with a rival at the start, settled while off the rail, moved out in upper stretch and closed strongly to get up at the wire. TRAIN WRECK set the pace, was challenged near the seven-sixteenths pole, vied inside on the far turn, edged clear in upper stretch, remained clear into the final sixteenth but bobbed near the wire and was caught. IM YOUR DEVIL raced three wide on the first turn, settled just off the pace, made a bid near the seven-sixteenths pole, vied outside on the far turn and weakened while able to get the show. ELUSIVE ROSSI was a bit rank early then rated while off the pace, raced off the rail on the far turn and lacked the needed response. DANCIN INTHE STARS settled in the middle of the field while near the rail, saved ground on the far turn, steadied inside the quarter-pole and failed to rally. SWEETANDSOURGAL broke outward at the start, was rated on the inside, saved ground into the stretch, had the rider lose his whip passing the three-sixteenths pole and came up empty. SKIPPING ON BY was rank early, raced four then three wide on the first turn, dropped to one off the rail late on that turn, raced well back in the field, went three wide on the far turn and failed to threaten. CLEVER PRADO broke a bit slow, raced four wide on the first turn, lingered towards the rear, went three wide on the far turn, steadied inside the quarter-pole and was no factor. IS THAT YOU DEAR bumped with a rival at the start, was rank early, lagged near the back while saving ground, hesitated a bit at the top of the stretch and never reached contention. KIP'S CHROME broke a bit slow, was a bit rank early, raced three wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, came up empty while off the rail on the far turn and dropped out. SEARCHING FOR GOLD broke a bit slow, dropped to the rail on the first turn,

lagged at the rear, saved ground on the far turn and showed little. MADAM IRISH was carried out a bit at the start, raced three then two wide on the first turn, made a strong middle move, chased three wide on the far turn and was used up. (Rail at 20 Feet)
