FOR THREE YEAR OLDS. By subscription of \$200 by Saturday, January 2. (Louisiana Derby early bird nominees automatically subscribed); \$1,000 to enter; \$1,000 additional to start. Supplemental nominations of \$5,000 will be accepted at time of entry which shall include all fees. \$200,000 Guaranteed of which 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 4% to fourth, 2% to fifth and 1% to finishers sixth through ninth. Weight: 122 lbs. Non-winners of \$36,000 allowed 2 lbs.; \$25,000 allowed 4 lbs.; \$20,000 allowed 6 lbs. (Maiden and claiming races not considered in estimating allowances). Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. The LeComte Stakes will be limited to fourteen (14) starters. Preference to horses with the highest lifetime earnings. Different owners have equal draw according to weights. Horses having common ties through ownership cannot start to the exclusion of a single interest. Any horse excluded from running because of the aforementioned preference shall be refunded the entry fee or supplementary nomination fee if applicable. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. Nominations closed Saturday, January 2, 2016 with 5.

Footnotes

MO TOM hit the gate at the start, bumped soundly with FISH TRAPPE ROAD nearing the first turn, raced in the two path early on that bend then dropped to the rail, settled well off the pace, moved closer while inside early on the far turn, shifted three wide at the five-sixteenths, angled out in upper stretch, came under a left-handed whip outside the furlong marker, rallied on the outside and closed strongly to win going away. TOM'S READY went three then four wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, was ridden along while four then five wide on the far turn, advanced coming to the quarter-pole, rallied to the lead in upper stretch, led into the final sixteenth under the whip but was overtaken while able to get the place. UNCLE WALTER bumped with rivals on both sides at the start, raced inside early on the first turn then came off the rail, settled off the pace, was urged along while three then four wide on the far turn, advanced to make a bid under a left-handed whip in upper stretch, dropped back into the final furlong, switched to a right-handed whip outside the sixteenth-pole and was outfinished while clear for the show. DESTIN went two then three wide on the first turn, dropped back onto the backstretch, was urged along near the middle of the field, raced in the two path on the far turn, moved out under the whip in upper stretch and failed to threaten. Z ROYAL bumped lightly with

UNCLE WALTER at the start, raced in the two path on the first turn, set the pace through solid fractions, was urged along in the two path on the far turn, lost the advantage in upper stretch and gave way. PINNACLE PEAK was hustled from the start, went three wide on the first turn, tracked the pace on the outside, chased three wide while hard ridden on the far turn and tired. FISH TRAPPE ROAD bobbed at the start then bumped with UNCLE WALTER, bumped soundly with MO TOM nearing the first turn, raced inside on that bend, moved up midway down the backstretch, was urged along while inside on the far turn and capitulated. MENDING FENCES raced in the two path on the first turn, settled towards the rear while coaxed along, was ridden along inside on the far turn and failed to respond. TARPON BAY ROAD went four then three wide on the first turn, fell well behind and was outrun.
